3. First Day of School (2 Jan 2024 for P1 only and 3 Jan 2024 for all Lasallians)

All <u>Primary 1 Lasallians</u> will report to school on <u>Tuesday, 2 January 2024</u>. School hours will be from 8 a.m. to 12 noon. Each P1 Lasallian may be accompanied by a maximum of <u>two</u> parent/guardians for the day. Please refer to the Parent Notification that was sent out on 27 December 2023 for details.

Primary 2 to Primary 6 Lasallians will remain at home on 2 January. Our school Student Care Centre (YMCA) will remain open for enrolled students <u>only in the afternoon</u>. Please contact the centre directly for details.

All Lasallians will return to school on <u>Wednesday, 3 January 2024</u>. Primary 1 Lasallians are to report directly to class while Primary 2 to 6 Lasallians will report to the Multi-Purpose Hall (MPH) by 7.30 a.m.

All Lasallians are to bring along a small bag with writing materials and food for their snack break. School attire: PE or School Uniform. Form Teachers will inform Lasallians of the packing list for the rest of the Week 1 when they report to school on 3 Jan.

4. Safety and Security

a. Attendance & Temperature-Taking Exercise (Week 2, Term 1)

To maintain the school's readiness and preparedness to re-activate the temperaturetaking regime should there be a need to and to educate our Lasallians to take personal responsibility for their own health and practice social responsibility, all MOE schools are required to conduct an Attendance & Temperature-Taking Exercise twice yearly.

The first semesterly exercise will be held in <u>Term 1, Week 2 (Wednesday, 10 January 2024)</u>.

Primary 2 to 6 Lasallians are to bring a working Oral Digital Thermometer (ODT) to school on that day for the exercise. They are required to bring their ODT for checks by their Form Teachers on Monday, 8 January 2024.

All <u>Primary 1</u> Lasallians will be issued with a free ODT by their Form Teachers.

b. Road Safety

The attached map of De La Salle School (<u>Annex 1</u>) shows the location of all the school gates. During operating hours, there will be a security officer or staff member on duty at each gate.

Gate Operating Hours

For Lasallians who walk to school

Lasallians are to use the pedestrian crossing along Choa Chu Kang St 52 and they are to cross the road at the stipulated traffic light crossing outside the school. Lasallians are reminded to adhere to road traffic rules and be vigilant of their surroundings. They should pay attention to oncoming traffic as they cross the road. Parents should refrain from attempting to cross the road bend in front of Gate B/C with our Lasallians as traffic is heavy during morning arrival and school dismissal times. They can enter or exit the school via Gate B or Gate E during morning arrival and school dismissal hours.

If you are driving your child to school

Please enter the school via Gate C if you are driving your child to school. To ensure a smooth traffic flow within the school premises, kindly prepare and ready your child <u>ahead</u> <u>of time</u> to alight promptly at the "Drop-off Point" at the porch of the Classroom Block.

For the safety of our Lasallians, do <u>not</u> alight Lasallians in the middle of the driveway. **Please do not alight together with your child** as this would hold up traffic unnecessarily leading to traffic congestion along Choa Chu Kang St 52. Do exercise patience and caution while driving along the driveway out towards Gate D to exit the school premises.

Gate D is an automatic gate. Do not be alarmed if Gate D is closed early in the morning. Please follow the instructions on the notice mounted on the gate to gain exit. During morning peak hours, Gate D is open and manned by one of the school staff.

Only school buses are allowed to drive into the school compound for school dismissal. Parents who drive to pick up their child are advised to arrive early and park at nearby carparks before walking over to Gate B or E. Parking outside the school along Choa Chu Kang St 52 is strictly <u>not</u> allowed and will only serve to increase traffic congestion and pose unnecessary road safety risks to our Lasallians.

School Bus & Public Transport

Lasallians who are travelling by school bus or public transport are to observe the rules and regulations when aboard the vehicles. Please remind your child that he/she should be properly seated and belted up where applicable. Lasallians are expected to behave themselves and not move around or talk loudly during the bus/train journey. They should not be snacking or drinking when travelling on the bus/train.

All Lasallians are to take responsibility to ensure their own safety and respect the need for the safety of others when travelling to school and back home.

Please refer to <u>Annex 2</u> for the road safety advisory from the Land Transport Authority and Singapore Police Force.

Cycling to School

Lasallians who wish to cycle to school will enter the school gate via Gate A where the bicycle stands are located. They should dismount when crossing the pedestrian crossing, looking out for oncoming traffic and not assume that they have the right of way, before entering the school gate.

Lasallians must obtain parental acknowledgement of an issued advisory note and be registered with the school before they are allowed to cycle to and park in school. For their safety, they are to don safety wear such as helmet and other protective gear such as proper shoes when cycling and ensure that their bicycles are well-lit in the early mornings. Please obtain the cycling advisory note from the school Operations Manager at the General Office.

c. School Security

To minimise the risk of intrusion, all visitors including parents are to obtain security clearance before being allowed entry into the school. Visitors are subject to prevailing security checks at the security post beside Gate B.

Parents who escort their children to school on foot or by public transport can leave their children at Gate B or E in the presence of the security officer and school personnel on duty. Parents who pick their children up after dismissal can wait outside these school gates.

If you wish to speak with a teacher or to attend to some administrative matters, please call the General Office ahead for an appointment. You may park your vehicle at a nearby carpark before reporting at the security post to register for a visitor's pass and then proceed to the General Office for assistance. You will have to don the visitor pass visibly throughout the duration of your visit.

The safety of our Lasallians is our top priority hence we seek your understanding and cooperation in helping us to provide a safe and secure learning environment for our Lasallians.

Taxis or private-hire vehicles are not allowed to enter or park at the school premises.

7. Parents Gateway App

Parents Gateway is an important online communication platform between MOE/School and parents. All parents are encouraged to download the application to their mobile phones to gain ready and convenient access to timely information pertaining to the school's programmes and activities.

8. Canteen Food Price Revision

In the recent 1-2 years, Singapore has seen a significant inflationary trend in food prices from the Department of Statistics (DOS) and NEA's hawker price survey. Our school canteen stallholders have expressed they have been facing challenges with rising costs, especially with costlier ingredients for healthy meals. MOE has issued a set of recommended guidelines on the proposed price range for medium portion meals for primary schools. Our canteen stall food prices are currently below this desired price range of \$2.00 - \$2.50 for medium portion meals without fruits.

To ensure that the pricing of our school canteen food reflect the underlying costs of the food items with a reasonable profit made by our stallholders, school has decided on the following revision to ensure food quality and stallholders' business are sustained:

From 2024 onwards, set meals for Lasallians will see an average increase of \$0.20/\$0.30 to \$1.80 (Small Portion) - \$2.10 (Large Portion). Prices for drinks such as Milo or tea/coffee will see an average increase of \$0.10. However, prices for additional side food items such as fishball, vegetables, egg, tauhu, etc and packet/bottled drinks will remain unchanged in 2024.

We hope that this information will help parents to estimate the daily pocket money that your child will need for his/her meal breaks in the canteen.

9. Use of Photographs and Videos involving Lasallians

During the course of the school year, photographs and videos of your child participating in instructional and school activities may appear on the school website and other school publications. When selecting photographs or videos to be featured, the school is mindful of the way our Lasallians may appear in them and will not include photographs and videos which are in any way inappropriate. Dear Parent/Guardian,

ROAD SAFETY OF STUDENTS

We would like to seek your cooperation to work with the school in ensuring the safety of students coming to and leaving school. This is especially important as young children may not have the skills required to use roads properly and do not always fully appreciate the dangers presented. Their small physique also makes them less visible to motorists.

This letter reiterates the road safety policies of the school:

- a. Reduce vehicle speed and stay alert for pedestrians in the school zone.
- b. Cooperate with traffic marshals to ensure overall safety and smooth traffic flow.
- c. Let your child alight only at the designated drop-off point.
- d. Be advised not to violate traffic rules by driving recklessly or making illegal manoeuvres such as turning into the school from the outer lane(s) of the road.
- e. Do not horn indiscriminately.
- f. Help your child alight from the car as quickly as possible.
- g. Reinforce correct road safety behaviour such as using the pedestrian crossing, and avoiding jaywalking or using a mobile phone while crossing.
- h. Remind your children to practise the kerb drill before crossing "look right, look left, look right again; ensure all vehicles have stopped; raise your hand high up and cross the road briskly".
- i. If your child must cycle to school, ensure that he knows safe cycling rules and is a competent cyclist.
- j. For the safety of everyone, enforcement action will be taken against motorists who violate traffic rules.

We thank all parents and guardians who have been the role models for our children.
