2. Youth Day cum General Office Closure

Please note that there will be no school for all Lasallians on **Monday, 7 July 2025**, due to Youth Day school holiday in lieu. The General Office will also be closed for staff training.

3. <u>Racial Harmony Day</u>

School will be commemorating Racial Harmony Day on Monday, 21 July 2025. To add to the celebratory mood for the occasion, Lasallians are encouraged to wear traditional ethnic costumes for the day. Alternatively, Lasallians can continue to wear their school uniform/PE attire on that day. All Lasallians are required to wear school shoes.

This year, the school will be partnering Limbang Community Arts and Culture (CACC) and their Youth Network (YN) in planning of the Racial Harmony Day Activities. Anchored in the theme of "Our People, Our Tapestry", Lasallians will be able to enjoy various activity booths on the various ethnic food, costumes, dance and art forms.

4. Attendance and Temperature-Taking Exercise (ATTEx)

The Attendance and Temperature-Taking Exercise is conducted twice yearly in all MOE schools with the aim to:

- a. Maintain schools' preparedness to re-activate the attendance and temperature-taking regime should the need arise; and
- b. Educate students on the importance of personal responsibility for their own health and social responsibility.

The ATTEx for Term 3, Semester 2, will be conducted on <u>Wednesday, 9 July 2025</u>. Lasallians are reminded to bring a working Oral Digital Thermometer to school on Tuesday, 8 July, for checking and safekeeping.

5. <u>School Emergency Preparedness & Response Exercise</u>

As part of the school's continual efforts to ensure our response readiness to any form of emergency, we will be organising our school-based **Evacuation Exercise within school and to an External Holding Area** in the beginning of Term 3. The entire school will participate in the Emergency Evacuation Exercise within school while only Primary 1 & 2 Lasallians will take part in the evacuation exercise to an External Holding Area so as to orientate them on the walking route. The External Holding Area identified for this exercise is Yew Tee Community Club.
