The month of May is a special one for all Lasallian schools as we celebrate Founder's Day on 15 May. It is a day to reflect on the rich history of the Lasallian mission and celebrate St John Baptist De La Salle. His dedication to providing education to the young, especially the poor around the world, has launched the worldwide Lasallian network. There are over 1,100 Lasallian educational institutions worldwide, in more than 80 countries across 5 continents serving over 1 million students. Our school is one of them.

As part of bonding with our Lasallian community, our P6 Lasallian leaders recently hosted students and teachers from La Salle School Bangkok (LSSB) for a day filled with friendship, learning, and cultural exchange. The P6 leaders had visited LSSB in November 2024. Lasallians from both schools participated in an Art and Technology workshop to learn more about each other's cultures before collaborating on digital artworks that celebrated their shared experiences. Students from St. Anthony's Primary School also joined in to host our guests over lunch and later brought them out on a learning journey to Gardens by the Bay.

The LSSB visit was a truly memorable experience that deepened the sense of our Lasallian spirit. Students exchanged the Asian handshake — a simple yet powerful symbol of unity, friendship, and mutual respect across cultures. This small but meaningful gesture reminds us that no matter where we come from, we are all connected through the Lasallian spirit. We look forward to more opportunities for meaningful exchanges and lasting friendships in the future.

### **2. Primary 3 CCA Experience Day**

Our Primary 3 Lasallians will be embarking on their Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) journey in Semester 2. To help both parents/guardians and Lasallians make an informed choice based on their interests and strengths, the school has planned a CCA Experience Day on Thursday, 8 May 2025, from 1.45p.m. to 3.45p.m.

During the Experience Day, CCA teachers and CCA leaders will facilitate a variety of engaging, hands-on activities to give students a taste of what each CCA offers. Each Primary 3 Lasallian will get to experience 4 different CCAs of their choice, helping them discover their preferences and areas of interest. To support this exploration, each student will be given a CCA Passport to record their experiences and reflections.

After the event, we encourage parents/guardians to speak with your child about what they enjoyed and which CCA they feel most excited to join. Do support and respect your child's choice, as this marks the beginning of a meaningful and enjoyable CCA journey.

### **3. Health Week 2025 (19 May – 23 May 2025)**

The school will be organising a Health Week, which aligns with 'Grow Well SG', a national health promotion strategy. The aim is to encourage our Lasallians to embrace healthy habits and make informed choices about their well-being.

From Monday, 19 May 2025, we will be organising a series of engaging activities during recess, centered around promoting a healthy lifestyle. Lasallians will have the opportunity to participate in fun and active events such as an assembly talk by a National Athlete, recess activities by the National Kidney Foundation and Singapore Heart Foundation. Following school dismissal, only the award recipients for the Primary 3 to Primary 5 (2024) Prize Giving Day will remain in school. Prize winners will join their parents/guardians for the ceremony from 11.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m.

## **5. Travel Declaration for Mid-Year School Holidays**
