#### **Principal's Note**

Dear Parents/Guardians,

This month, we look forward to celebrating our nation's 60<sup>th</sup> birthday. The theme for this year's National Day Parade is *Majulah Singapura* - a milestone to honour our journey, unite in celebration, and build our shared future together. Our P5 Lasallians attended the National Education Show on 12 July and were inspired to think about the role they would like to play in building Singapore together. All Lasallians will get the opportunity to pen their wishes for Singapore, sharing heartfelt hopes for the nation by reflecting on our Lasallian values – Faith, Service, and Community.



As part of National Education, our school commemorated Racial Harmony Day (RHD) on 21 July, with a vibrant line-up of activities anchored on this year's national theme, *Our People, Our Tapestry*. The celebration was made especially meaningful through a collaboration with the Youth Network and Community Arts & Culture Club from Limbang Constituency, bringing our community together to promote mutual respect and social cohesion.

Our Lasallians explored a series of interactive activity booths as part of their recess activities to learn more about the various cultures in Singapore, focused on Art, Dance, Food, and Language. Primary 6 Lasallians have persevered and have been working hard to prepare for the examinations. We have full confidence in them and wish them all the very best in their Oral Examinations.

All Primary 1 to 5 Lasallians do not report to school on these two days.

#### 4. Parent-Child-Teacher Conference for Primary 1 to Primary 5 Lasallians

School will be organising a Parent-Child-Teacher Conference (PCTC) for Primary 1 to Primary 5 Lasallians via MS Teams on Tuesday, 2 September 2025. If your child/ward is not travelling during the September holidays, no action is required.

#### 7. School PE Attire

Please note that DLSS will phase out the old PE attire by the end of this year. From January 2026 onwards, all Lasallians will need to wear the new PE attire. For Lasallians who have not purchased the new PE attire, please do so before the start of the next academic year in 2026.
